Visas for entry to Kenya

You may need to get a visa to enter Kenya, please visit http://evisa.go.ke/eligibility.html to check your eligibility status for your Country. If you are eligible you can apply for an e-visa online via http://evisa.go.ke/evisa.html (NOTE: the 'create an account' link at the foot of the page does not work, please use the one at the top of the page)

Visas are available at Kenyatta International Airport, however this is a lengthy process, so the above method is recommended.

Safari Park Hotel

The workshop will take place in the Safari Park Hotel just outside of Nairobi. If you are an IWC funded participant your room and airport transfer has already been booked. If you are a self-funded participant you will need to book this yourself. If you are a Pew, or WIOMSA funded participant you will need to check arrangements for booking.

If booking yourself, please also book your airport transfer between the airport to the Safari Park Hotel directly through the hotel. The transfer takes approximately 30 minutes depending on traffic.


Airport Transfers to Safari Park Hotel




