**Landing of one bowhead whale**

We have been informed by Fisheries and Oceans, Canada that, under the authority of a license issued by the Minister of Fisheries and Oceans, one bowhead whale was landed at Igloodik, Nunavut Territory, on 10<sup>th</sup> August 2002. The animal, harvested for aboriginal subsistence, was a female and measured 14.2m in length.
