At its meeting in May 2021 (SC68C) the Scientific Committee (SC) discussed the results of a review of the Strandings Initiative (SI) structure and function. Under this review a new four-year workplan has been developed which outlines needs for staffing and governance.

The SC recommended a refresh of the Strandings Steering Committee in accordance with the new Terms of Reference.
