**Financial Contributions for 2022: Reminder to pay by the 30 June Deadline**

This Circular Communication serves as a reminder to Contracting Governments that 2022 Contributions are due no later than 30 June 2022 in accordance with the Rules of Procedure.

The following Contracting Governments currently have unpaid contributions, amounting to £1.2 million, at the time of writing (20 June 2022):

Antigua and Barbuda, Belgium, Belize, Benin, Brazil, Bulgaria, Cambodia, Cameroon, Chile, Congo (Rep of), Costa Rica, Côte d'Ivoire, Dominica, Ecuador, Eritrea, Finland, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Grenada, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Hungary, India, Italy, Kenya, Kiribati, Lao (PDR), Liberia, Luxembourg, Mali, Mauritania, Mongolia, Nauru, Oman, Panama, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Sao Tome & Principe, Slovenia, Solomon Islands, St Vincent & The Grenadines, Suriname, Tanzania, Togo, Tuvalu, United Kingdom, and Uruguay.

Contracting Governments are urged to send payment of 2022 contributions and any arrears as soon as possible. Timely payment of contributions is essential to ensure that the Commission can meet its financial obligations.
