## 1. Introduction

- 1.1. Membership of the Budgetary Sub-Committee (BSC) is composed of representatives from each capacity to pay group, along with two seats open to any Contracting Government. The two highest paying members in Group 4 (USA and UK) are permanent members.
- 1.2. Following a change adopted at IWC 65 in 2014, BSC members representing capacity to pay groups serve for a four-year term, the open seats serve a two-year term.
- 1.3. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, membership durations were extended.
- 1.4. The current membership is given in the table below, along with the expected future membership. The number of years served for each member is given in brackets.
