The changes are as follows:

- Mr Michael Stachowitsch (Austria) will continue as Chair of the Sub-Committee on Whale Killing Methods and Associated Welfare Issues instead of Mr Herman Oosthuizen as previous stated.
- Mexico has been added to the membership of the Ship Strikes Working Group (SSWG)
- The membership of the Aboriginal Subsistence Whaling Working Group (ASWWG) has been amended to show both Australia and Norway as Scientific Committee members (see Circular Communication IWC.CCG.984 for background)
- The membership of the Standing Working Group on Whalewatching (SWG-WW) has been amended to include two Scientific Committee representatives
- The membership of the Intersessional Group on Anthropogenic Sound has been amended to include Argentina.
