Amendments to the Schedule
International Convention for the Regulation of Whaling, 1946

At the 52nd Annual Meeting of the International Whaling Commission held in Adelaide, Australia, 3 – 6 July 2000 no modifications were made to the provision for zero catch limits for commercial whaling with effect from the 1986 coastal and the 1985/86 pelagic seasons. The following amendments to the Schedule of the International Convention for the Regulation of Whaling are therefore necessary (changes in **bold type**):

Paragraphs 11 and 12, and Tables 1, 2 and 3:

Substitute the dates **2000/2001** pelagic season, **2001** coastal season, **2001** season, or **2001** as appropriate.

These amendments become effective with respect to each Contracting Government ninety days following the date of this letter, in accordance with Article V of the Convention, unless any Contracting Government lodges an objection, in which case the procedure under Article V, paragraph 3 of the Convention will be followed.

The ninety days period will expire on **15 October 2000**. In the absence of objections by that date the amendments will become effective. Contracting Governments will be notified accordingly.

Contracting Governments are reminded that Article V paragraph 3 of the Convention requires them to acknowledge receipt of this notification of amendments. In order to encourage compliance with this requirement, a form of acknowledgement is attached, to be completed and returned by post, fax or email as is most convenient.
