<u>October Meetings in Cambridge - Special Meeting of the Commission and the RMS intersessional:</u> <u>Travel to Cambridge from London's airports</u>

Further to Circular Communication IWC.CCG.269 dated 20 August 2002 regarding travel arrangements for the forthcoming meetings in Cambridge, we now attach timetables for coach travel between:

Stansted Airport - Cambridge Heathrow Airport - Cambridge Gatwick Airport - Cambridge

and train services between Stansted Airport and Cambridge.

Further information on train times from Heathrow and Gatwick Airports is available from the following internet address: <u>www.rail.co.uk</u>. Information on journey times and frequency is provided below:

<u>By train from Gatwick to Cambridge:</u> Trains leave every 30 minutes – Journey time: Approx. 2 hrs (1 change)

<u>By train from Heathrow to Cambridge:</u> Trains leave every 30 minutes - Journey time: Approx. 2 hrs (1-2 changes)

The De Vere University Arms, the Royal Cambridge and the Crowne Plaza hotels are all a short taxi journey from either the train or coach station although both, and particularly the coach station, are within walking distance (see map attached).

Finally, could I remind those Contracting Governments who have not yet done so, to provide information by 30 September on their delegations to both the Special Meeting and to the RMS intersessional as requested in Circular Communication IWC.CCG.269.
