Proposals for Timing and Duration of IWC65 in 2014

Executive Secretary

Rule of Procedure B.2 states: 'Before the end of each Biennial Meeting, the Commission shall decide on: (1) the length of the next Biennial Commission Meeting and associated meetings and (2) which of the Commission's sub-groups need to meet'.

No decisions regarding the duration of IWC65, or which sub-groups need to meet were taken at IWC64 in 2012.

IWC Biennial Meetings comprise a series of Sub-committee and working group meetings followed by a four or five day plenary session. The scheduling and duration of the meetings reflect both the amount of business to be discussed as well as costs and availability of venues. By way of example, the timetable of IWC64 held in Panama in 2012 ran over 12 days as follows:
