Travel to the venue

It is recommended that participants fly to Skukuza International Airport http://skukuzaairport.com/. Flights operate to Skukuza from Johannesburg and Cape Town. **Buses will be organised to collect participants from flights arriving in Skukuza on Monday 2nd May and for the return trip to Skukuza airport on Saturday 7th May. Visas

Participants are asked to check and fulfil visa requirements in advance of travel. Please contact <u>secretariat@iwc.int</u> for assistance with visas if needed.

Health

Participants are encouraged to consult with their national healthcare providers regarding required or recommended inoculations in advance of travel. Malaria is present in Kruger national park and participants are encouraged to consider appropriate precautions.

Accommodation and meals

Accommodation at Skukuza Rest Camp for all workshop participants has been booked for the nights 2nd -6th May inclusive and costs will be covered by the IWC. **Please note therefore that participants do not need to make their own hotel booking, unless you need any additional nights outside these dates.** Accommodation will be in bungalows and these have been booked for single occupancy.

Lunch and soft drinks will be provided. **Please inform the Secretariat of any dietary requirements.** Participants will need to pay for their own breakfast and dinner, in addition to any other extra costs on their room bill.
