Systematic observations from the coast on Southern right whales - Mar del Plata city	Whale monitoring is carried out through systematic weekly surveys in different points of the urban area of Mar del Plata city. Sightings are performed at different times of the day using binoculars. Geographical position, photographs, number of individuals, presence or absence of calves and types of behavior displayed is recorded at each sighting. Months: Sept - Oct. Number of sightings: 15	National Collator
Survey the Atlantic coast of Tierra del Fuego, the Beagle Channe, Isla de Iso Estados and Banco Namunucura/Burdwood Bank.	During 2017/2018 season one cruise was conducted in the Atlantic coast of Tierra del Fuego, the Beagle Channel, around of Isla de los Estados and in the marine protected area Namuncura/Burdwood Bank on board of the vessel BO Puerto Deseado of the CONICET. Sighting survey was conducted daily, using standard line-transect methods during daylight hours. Observers collected the data, from the port and starboard sides of the vessel respectively, to maintain a continuous search for cetaceans, through naked eye scans supplemented by use of 7x50 power binoculars. Data recorded for each sighting included GPS position, date and time, species, group size and composition. Vessel speed, air temperature, wind speed and direction, Beaufort Sea State (BSS), cloud cover and visibility were recorded at the start of each day and updated whenever one of them changed. Results of this cruise are summarized in Dellabianca & Cortes 2017.	National Collator
Aerial surveys of southern right whales off the coast of Península Valdés, Argentina	Aerial surveys of southern right whales off the coast of Península Valdés, Argentina, were conducted on September 9 and 10, 2017. The purpose of the surveys was to document the presence and distribution of southern right whales along the perimeter of the Península by photo-identifying individuals from the callosity patterns on their heads and recording their locations and the presence of calves. A total of 788 southern right whales including 302 calves were counted, and 12,200 photographs were taken. The total count of 788 whales is the highest we have ever recorded since the beginning of the study in 1970. Final results of photo-identification analyses are not yet available. The following table summarizes the number of whales counted by area: Golfo San José (GSJ), Golfo Nuevo (GN) and the total in Península Valdés (PV). Analyses of photographs in the right whale catalogue of ICB-OA are available for the years 1970-2015. Number of individuals photo-identified: 3,200.	National Collator
