### **Executive Secretary of the International Whaling Commission**

The International Whaling Commission (IWC) invites applications for the post of Executive Secretary. This is a four-year appointment with the possibility of an extension of up to four years.

The IWC is an international organisation with a membership of 88 Contracting Governments. It is the global body responsible for the conservation of whales and the management of whaling and its headquarters are in Cambridge, United Kingdom.

The Executive Secretary is the Head of the Commission's Secretariat and must be impartial in co-ordinating the interests of all member Governments. S/he is responsible for the efficient management of the Secretariat including development and execution of the Commission's budget and associated programme of work, organisation of meetings of the Commission and its subsidiary bodies, and maintenance of relationships with other international organisations.

Prospective candidates must have proven leadership and management ability. Experience in the international arena, especially with inter-governmental organisations would be advantageous.

The Commission has a separate management grade for the post of Executive Secretary. The starting gross salary for this role will be £117,511 British Pounds and the role will be based in Cambridge, UK.
