Venue and dates

The 66a session of the International Whaling Commission's Scientific Committee (SC66a) will take place in San Diego, California, United States, from 22 May to 3 June 2015 at the San Diego Marriott Marquis and Marina: http://www.marriott.com/hotels/event-planning/travel/sandt-marriott-marquis-san-diego-marina/.
