The signatories of the present Letter of Intent would like to express their interest in the organisation and hosting of the:

67th A Meeting of the Scientific Committee of the International Whaling Commission from 7 to 21 May 2017 in Bled, Slovenia.

The 67th A Meeting of the IWC Scientific Committee is a 12-14 day event with a few additional premeeting days. It will attract around 150-200 participants, especially scientists and government representatives from all over the world.

In the event industry, the Jupiter Convention Centre at Sava Hotels in Bled is one of the major players in SE Europe. It is an ideal choice of venue for such an important and high-profile international meeting.
